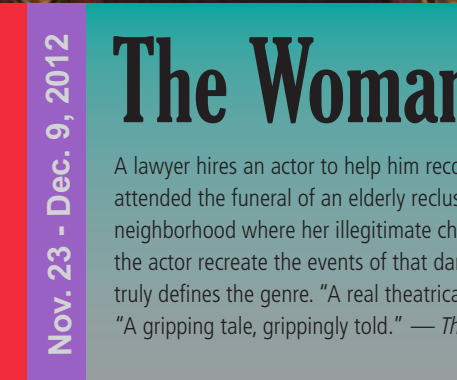

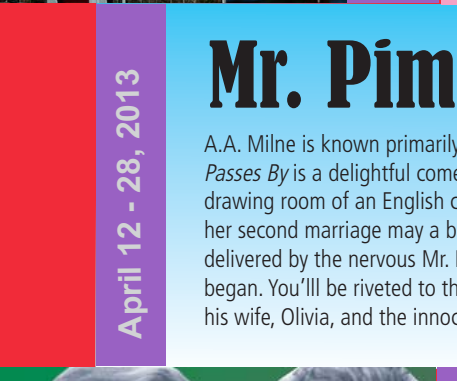
PLAY 3

Set in the 1920s drawing room of an English country home, the plot centers on the mistress of the house who learns that her second marriage may be a bigamous one, since her first husband may not be dead. This intelligence is delivered by the nervous Mr. Pim, who periodically returns to revise his reports and add to the chaos he began. You'll be riveted to the grandeur of Aunt Julia, the insensitivity of George, the love and care of his wife, Olivia, and the innocence of Mr. Pim as he stirs the cauldron of human personalities.

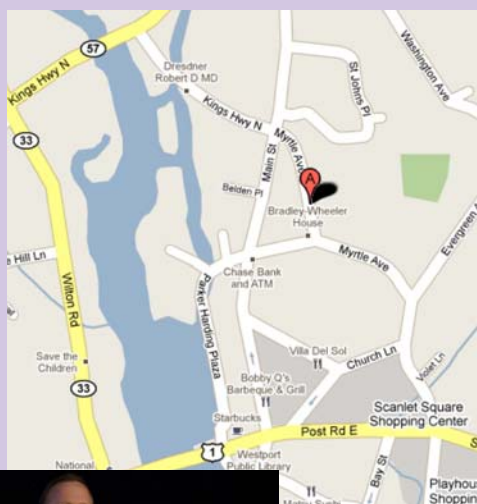

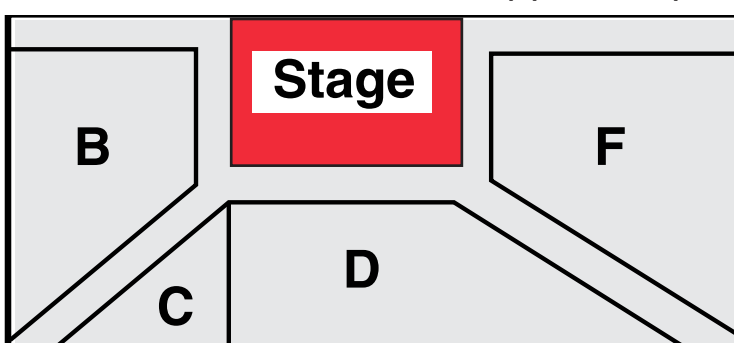
